92 points

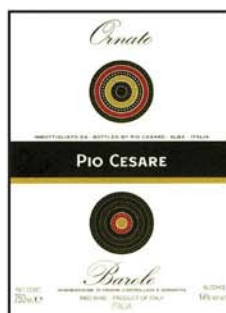


"Rose petal and berry aromas follow through to a full body, with chewy yet velvety tannins and a long finish. Offers a serious depth of fruit. Best after 2011."

95 points

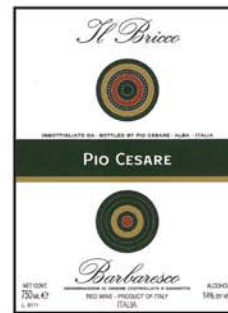
