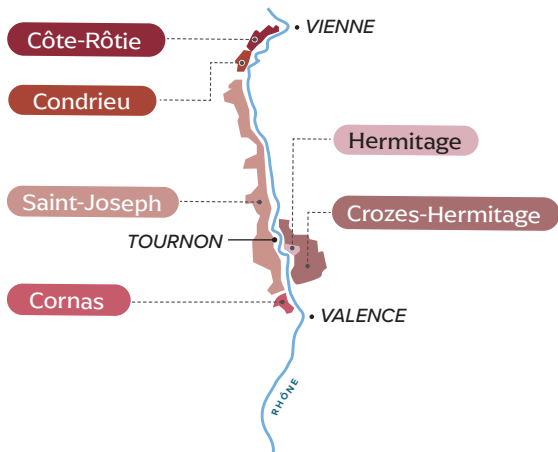

### Côte-Rôtie



#### Côte-Rôtie La Landonne 2023

**97PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | A giant Cote-Rotie, but this is a giant of subtlety and refinement. The spectrum of aromas is incredibly complex, the forest berry, spice, savory and mineral elements weaving a great tapestry. Enormous concentration is married to a mind-blowingly silky texture that extends right through the super-long and precise finish.

#### Côte-Rôtie Seigneur de Maugiron 2023

**94PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | A serious Cote-Rotie that's currently quite closed, the black fruit aromas slowly expanding in the glass and gently pushing the graphite to one side. There's interplay of fine, generous tannins and beautifully ripe fruit. I love that the texture of the tannins switches from silky on the front palate to firmer and more velvety in the finish. Needs time for the complexity to develop. This is the first vintage of this wine, and it matured primarily in large oak foudres.

#### St. Joseph Sainte-Épine 2023

**96PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | An exceptionally full-bodied and rich wine for this appellation, but it is still quite closed. A compact structure of very fine tannins clothed in a cloud of black fruit aromas. Very long, velvety finish that somehow manages to be delicate in spite of the abundant power. A single-vineyard wine from a south-facing site. A pure syrah that was matured exclusively in Burgundian oak barrels, with less than a third new oak.

#### Hermitage Ligne de Crête 2023

**99PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | How can a wine as powerful and concentrated as a great Hermitage have this mind-blowing finesse? The stony and wind-swept nature of this vineyard site is precisely reflected in this masterpiece of purity, delicacy and wild herb freshness. It's hard to put all this into words, most of all the extraordinary mineral energy in the almost endless finish. From a vineyard site with up to 320 meters altitude.

#### Hermitage Les Bessards 2023

**98PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | A haunting nose of raw meat, smoke and licorice. Incredible concentration, the power expertly reined in, with enormous finesse. As it aerates, the beautifully ripe forest berry aromas expand and expand. Then the fun really starts with the almost endless finish. Fundamental stony minerality glides over your palate and off into the distance. From an almost pure granite soil in one of the best sections of the hill of Hermitage.

#### Hermitage Domaine des Tourettes 2023

**95PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | This stunning Hermitage is simultaneously expansive and graceful with a very wide spectrum of red-fruit aromas and very fine tannins. Also floral, wet-stone and graphite character. It would be hard not to love this for the wonderful harmony on the front- and mid-palates alone, then comes the fleshy yet structured finish that pulls you back for more.

### Crozes-Hermitage



#### Crozes-Hermitage Le Clos 2023

**95PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | Still very young and a little bit closed (with some graphite aroma), this great Crozes-Hermitage has a very compact structure and excellent concentration. But what makes it really stand out is the wonderful freshness that lights up the long, stony finish. As the wine aerates in the glass, the peppery, savory and meaty aromas of syrah unfurl like a flag in the wind. From a small, west-facing slope that looks toward the Rhone. Excellent aging potential but can be drunk from release.

## BLANC

### Condrieu



#### Condrieu Clos Boucher 2023

**95PTS JAMESUCKLING.COM** | Seamless integration of ripe stone fruit, tropical flower and coconut aromas with restrained richness and fine oak tannins. I love the textural complexity of this seductive Condrieu on the medium- to full-bodied palate. Long, creamy finish with delightful citrus freshness. From a site very close to Chateau Grillet, with more than 40-year-old vines. Matured in Burgundian oak barrels for one year, then a further six months on the lees in stainless steel.

#### Condrieu La Galopine 2024

**95PTS** *James Suckling* | Lively and gourmand, the 2024 Condrieu La Galopine wafts from the glass with aromas of honeysuckle, pear, white fruits and spices mingled with fresh menthol notes. Medium- to full-bodied, fleshy and enveloping, it's dense and concentrated, built around a vibrant core of fruit that carries through a long, perfumed finish. The acidity is preserved by blocking malolactic fermentation on the Viognier, lending the wine notable freshness and tension.

#### Hermitage Domaine des Tourettes Blanc 2024

**95-97PTS JEB DUNNUCK** | The 2024 Hermitage Domaine Des Tourettes Blanc reveals quince, honeyed white flowers, mint, and a beautiful sense of minerality on the nose. It's medium to full-bodied, has a pure, layered, finesse-driven mouthfeel, and its oak is beautifully integrated. It has richness and freshness as well as a great finish. It's up with the crème de la crème of the vintage.
