Tracing its roots back to 1912, Domaines Ott wines represent the best of Provence: beauty, heritage, and unsurpassed character. Today, fourth-generation cousins Christian and Jean-François Ott manage the three estates, totaling over 500 acres of vineyards, to produce wines of two appellations: Côtes de Provence and Bandol. Before a manual harvest, grapes are grown without the use of chemical fertilizers, pesticides, or herbicides, respecting both the environment and the Provençal tradition—a nod to founder Marcel Ott’s enduring legacy.

HEV-3 (High Environmental Value)

High environmental value (HEV) corresponds to the highest level of a more general scheme of environmental certification for farms. HEV covers four key areas: biodiversity conservation, plant protection strategy, management of fertilizer use and management of water.
