Tracing its roots back to 1912, Domaines Ott wines represent the best of Provence: beauty, heritage, and unsurpassed character. Today, fourth-generation cousin Jean-François Ott manages the three estates, totaling over 500 acres of vineyards, to produce wines of two appellations: Côtes de Provence and Bandol. Before a manual harvest, grapes are grown without the use of chemical fertilizers, pesticides, or herbicides, respecting both the environment and the Provençal tradition—a nod to founder Marcel Ott's enduring legacy.



CHÂTEAU DE SELLE CÔTES DE PROVENCE ROSÉ 2023

VARIETALS: 55% GRENACHE, 25% CINSAULT, 14% MOURVEDRE, 6% SYRAH

The wine displays an elegant peach hue flecked with silver. The nose opens with a hint of exotic fruits, followed by notes of jasmine and white-fleshed fruit, wrapped in a delicate minerality. On the palate, the wine is remarkably soft, revealing all the complexity of the summer fruit. Its silky texture evolves gently towards a chalky, mineral finish, set off by a subtle hint of white pepper.

CLOS MIREILLE CÔTES DE PROVENCE ROSÉ 2023

VARIETALS: 80% GRENACHE, 15% CINSAULT, 5% ROLLE

Seductive pale pink hue tinged with sandy gold. The nose is exquisitely delicate with notes of yellow fruit and acacia blossom. On the palate, the wine is invigorating, vivacious, with lingering aromas of yellow fruit delicately interwoven with the scent of melon. The soft, slightly spicy finish reveals intense notes of candied lemon peel.

CHÂTEAU ROMASSAN BANDOL ROSÉ 2023

VARIETALS: 50% MOURVÈDRE, 30% CINSAULT, 20% GRENACHE

The wine reveals a beautiful peach hue, reminiscent of rose gold. The nose is enveloping with aromas of candied citrus, evolving towards lemon verbena leaves. On the palate, the wine is clean and reveals notes of red fruits—strawberries and raspberries. The midpalate is tight, fresh and very harmonious. The wine is delicious, right up to the finely balanced finish, perfumed with a hint of pomelo.



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
