THE APPELLATION

This appellation produces very fresh wines which can be kept. One finds the presence of red fruit as well as flowery notes evocative of violets, irises, roses and peonies. The palate is very structured.

HARVEST AND VINIFICATION

The grapes are picked by hand followed by an alcoholic and malolactic fermentation in vats. The wine is then matured in vats followed by clarification before being bottled.

TASTING NOTES

A dark red color with violet highlights. An expressive bouquet full of the aromas of red fruit (raspberries and strawberries) accompanied by a small and agreeable vegetable point. The palate is agreeable and elegant with a frank attack accompanied by a light tangy note.

The Region

FLEURIE

Location: Between the crus of Moulin à Vent and Chiroubles - Beaujolais.

Area: 875 hectares.

Aspect: South East and North West.

Soil: Amphitheatre of granite.

Grape: Gamay.

This great vineyard, created on a homogeneous geological site made up of granite and large crystals which brings finesse and charm to this wine. This appellation has been made up of 13 different parcels of vines since 1936.
